SPARTAN STANDARD DRESS ATTIRE

Standard School Attire Requirements for the 2018-2019 School Year Students are required to wear Standard School Attire every day at CMS.

Our standard school attire teaches students to dress for success. For our student's safety, there are *no exceptions* to this policy. In the event that a special jeans day or other dress day is going to occur, information will be provided to students and parents in advance.

QUICK GUIDE – DAILY WEAR

SHIRT	SOLID COLOR WITH A COLLAR: BLACK, WHITE, BLUE, YELLOW, GRAY
PANTS	SOLID: KHAKI OR NAVY BLUE (NO JEANS/LEGGINGS/BLACK PANTS)
SHORTS / SKIRTS	SOLID: KHAKI OR NAVY BLUE (NO JEANS, MUST BE AT LEAST KNEE LENGTH)
SWEATSHIRTS (WITH COLLARED SHIRT)	SOLID: BLACK, WHITE, BLUE, YELLOW, GRAY. (NO HOODIES)
SHOES	CLOSED TOE SHOES (NO SLIDES, SANDALS, OR SLIPPERS)
HEADWEAR	BANDANAS, HEADWRAPS, AND FOREHEAD BANDS ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Shirts:

- All shirts **MUST** have a collar and cannot be sleeveless.
- Shirts must be a **SOLID** color: blue, black, yellow, white or gray **ONLY**.
- No patterns, markings, labels or other designs on the shirt except an emblem that is no larger than 2"x3" on the upper left pocket area or sleeve.

Sweaters/Sweatshirts:

- All sweaters and sweatshirts must be **SOLID** colored in blue, black, yellow, white or gray.
- No patterns, markings, labels or other designs on the shirt except an emblem that is no larger than 2"x3" on the upper left pocket area or sleeve.
- No pictures, labels or writing may be on the back of a sweatshirt or sweater.
- A standard school shirt **MUST** be worn underneath with the collar showing.
- Turning sweatshirts or jackets inside out or **tucking in a hood** will not be an acceptable correction to Standard School Attire.

Pants and Shorts:

- Pants and shorts may be **NAVY BLUE or KHAKI only**.
- **BLACK PANTS, DENIM/JEANS, GYM (SWEAT PANTS), OR ATHLETIC JOGGERS/TRACK PANTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED.**
- No leggings, jeggings or other skin-tight fabric is permitted unless covered by a skirt.
- Pants must be solid with no patterns, labels or other markings.
- Shorts may not be shorter than 3" above the knee. No cut offs are allowed. All shorts must have a hem.
- There may be no holes or tears in pants.

NO HOODED SWEATERS OR HOODED SWEATSHIRTS ARE ALLOWED TO BE WORN DURING THE SCHOOL DAY.

Standard School Attire Requirements Continued

Skirts/Dresses:

- Skirts and dresses must be **NAVY BLUE or KHAKI only**.
- **BLACK, DENIM/JEANS, SKIN TIGHT DRESSES/SKIRTS ARE NOT PERMITTED.**
- Skirts and dresses must be solid with no patterns, labels or other markings.
- Skirts and dresses may not be shorter than 3" above the knee.
- Solid **NAVY BLUE or KHAKI** jumpers should be worn with a standard school attire collared shirt underneath.

Outside wear:

- Coats, windbreakers, hooded sweatshirts and other types of jackets may be worn to school **but must remain in a student's locker throughout the day.**
- Knit hats, scarves, gloves and other cold weather accessories must be placed in a student's locker after arriving to school.
- Outerwear scarves are not permitted to be worn throughout the day.
- Track jackets with stripes down the sleeves may be worn as long as they are black, white, blue, yellow or gray.

Head Wear:

- Headbands and other hair accessories such as hair clips or other items whose intended use are solely as a hair accessory are allowed as long as they are not distracting.
- Baseball hats and other hats are **NOT** permitted

Shoes:

- No open toe shoes or sandals, nor any heels over 1" are allowed.
- Boots are also permitted.

Belts:

- May only be worn around the waist in belt loops.

Jewelry:

- School appropriate jewelry must be worn in a non-distracting manner.
- Any jewelry that has sharp or spiked ends or any style that could pose a danger is not permitted.

BANDANAS, HEADWRAPS, AND FOREHEAD BANDS ARE NOT PERMITTED AS HAIR ACCESSORIES

Administration reserves the right to ask any student who is wearing an item or items deemed distracting or inappropriate to call home and get an alternate outfit. Standard school attire may also be amended or revised with notice at any time

All items may be purchased from any department store, Target, Sears, Wal-Mart, JCPenny, or any official uniform vendor.
