Therefore in order to sustain this honor, each individual must take responsibility to conduct himself or herself by demonstrating honesty and integrity in their conduct. Acts of lying or cheating compromise the principles of what it means to be a citizen of Campbell Middle School. As an IB school the expectation is that each student will strive to promote respect, responsibility, honesty and compassion and will encourage the same conduct from their fellow students. This means unless otherwise indicated, any work submitted by a student is to be the original work of that student since cheating and plagiarism undermine the basic trust that must exist between the faculty and students.

 - After the first offense, all subsequent offenses will be directed to the administrator for insubordination. Incidents of cheating are cumulative over the student's middle school enrollment.
