Hendricks Elementary School is in the process of selecting new members to the School Council to replace the members whose term had been completed. The formation of this council is a result of education reforms passed by the Georgia Legislature. The primary purpose of the School Council is to bring schools and communities closer together in a spirit of cooperation to solve problems, improve academic achievement, provide support for teachers and administrators, and bring parents into the school-based decision-making process! As you can imagine, this is a very rewarding experience that involves some commitment of time, discussion and sharing of ideas.

Who can run for the School Council? Any parent or guardian of a student enrolled in Hendricks Elementary School, excluding those parents that are also employees of the school. By law, the council consists of parents, teachers, and the assistant principal of the school. Terms run for two years. This year three new parents will be elected to serve on the council.
