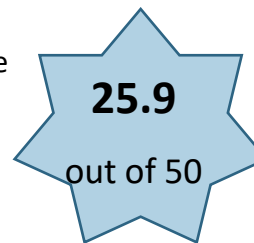

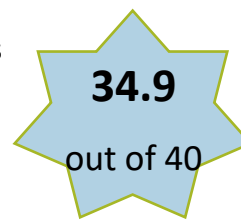
Achievement

- Graduation Rate



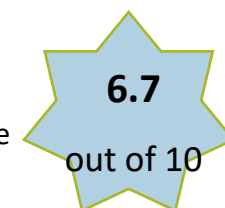
Progress
