(Ex: Place a "1" by your 1st choice elective, a "2" by your 2nd choice elective, a "3" by your 3rd choice elective, etc.) Guidance counselors will use these selections when building your schedule for next year. Understand that you may be placed in ANY elective that you select for EITHER semester. Additionally, please keep in mind that all freshmen at Pebblebrook HS will take the Freshmen Seminar elective course. All electives at PHS are semester classes which means that you will switch electives in January. The only exception to this rule is our band and orchestra classes. Regardless of the rank number listed, students who sign up for band or orchestra WILL BE IN THE CLASS FOR BOTH SEMESTERS. Students who have never taken a music class should NOT register for band or orchestra. **Students and their parents should complete the elective registration forms and return them to the homeroom teacher by Friday, February 10th.**

What are the high school graduation requirements for incoming 9th grade students?

Graduation Requirements for students entering 9th grade in 2017

- Pass all required coursework
 - ▣ 23 Credits (units) minimum
- EOC will count for 20% of course grade
 - Must pass EOC Courses to graduate
 - Algebra/Geometry, Biology, U.S. History/Econ, 9th Lit/Amer. Lit
- Must choose and complete a Career or College Pathway (3 courses)

Required Credits

- 4 units of English
- 4 units of Math
- 4 units of Science
- 3 units of Social Studies (World His, US His, Econ/Gov)
- 1 Physical Education (.5 Health/.5 Personal Fitness)
- 3 CTAE or Fine Arts or Foreign Language
- 4 units of electives (A minimum of 2 units of the same foreign language is required for college admission)

PEBBLEBROOK ACADEMIES

Pebblebrook High School has made a transformational change by creating academies. Students will be exposed to the two different academies during their freshmen year and will select an academy of study by their sophomore year. Students will take blended courses that will provide them with up to 10 credits for their first year at Pebblebrook.

- English (9th Lit, Honors 9th Lit)
- Math (GSE Algebra or GSE Accelerated Algebra/Analytical Geometry A)
- Science

Ninth grade advisement

- **Second semester of 9th grade**
- **Parents, students and teachers meet and create a 4-year course plan and pre-register for 10th grade courses**

Daily grades are available online via Synergy/Parentvue code access that students will get in homeroom and parents may get in main office

(checking grades, transcript, turning in work on-time, etc.)
