Core Courses

- All core classes will be recommended for each student by his or her current instructor.
- Kennesaw Mountain will finalize the schedule. It will be viewable via StudentVue and ParentVUE by 3/15/19.
- Students will be assigned two core classes per semester.
- A waiver may be submitted no later than 3/28/19

Electives

- All elective classes will be selected by students and parents.

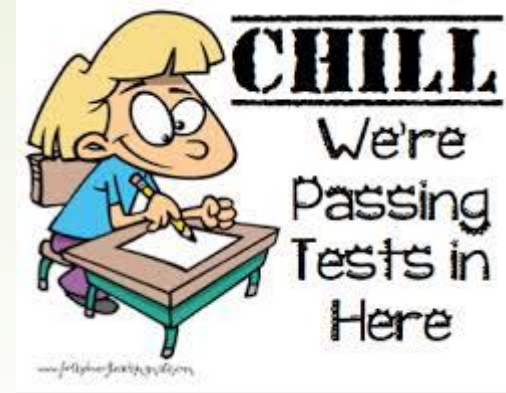
