Here is your “Course Request Profile”. It lists all the courses you are registered for next year. It does not show which semester or the block you will take the class. Please make sure you have 8 courses listed under “Course Requests” (2 skinnies count as one course) as these are your **primary courses** to take next year.

Under “Alternate Course Requests” are additional courses that we will schedule for you if one of the original 8 courses does not work. If you do not have any courses listed under there, or if none of them will work in your schedule, one of the schedulers will choose a course for you if needed. Please make sure you have as many additional alternate courses as you like.

There are a few changes to course offerings since we originally registered students. Those changes are:

1. We will now be offering a **Sports & Entertainment Marketing Pathway**. Please indicate if you would like either of the following courses:
  - a. **Marketing Principles** – first level course in the pathway
  - b. **Intro to Sports & Entertainment Marketing** – second level course in the pathway if you complete Marketing Principles in the fall
2. We are no longer offering the electronics pathway. Students who have already started the pathway will have an opportunity to complete it next year, but no Foundations of Electronics courses will be offered. We have removed all requests for Foundations of Electronics. The skinny was replaced with Intro to Digital Technology.

Please note that we will make any necessary changes based on any failed classes at the end of the semester. If a student fails a class, the scheduling team assumes all control of that student’s schedule in order to ensure the student retakes the necessary classes to graduate on time.

You may not add Video or Newspaper at this time as those courses required an application. If you requested one of those courses and it is not listed, then your application was not approved.

AP Psychology and AP European History rosters have also been reviewed by the teacher. If that course was removed from your list, it means that you do not meet the prerequisites for the course.

The Band and Orchestra teachers have notified us of the correct placement level, and those adjustments have been made.

AVID may be added to your courses later if you have interviewed for that course and are accepted.
