



## Wildcat Tutoring

Tutoring for Math, Science, English, and Social Studies is held every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:45 p.m. – 4:45 p.m. in the school cafeteria. There are some blackout dates that are announced including March 17 (Academic Success Night) and April 23 (Senior Project Night). Wheeler High School teachers and members of the National Honor Societies will be available for all core class subjects to provide academic enrichment, remediation and small group instruction during this time. To attend the tutorial sessions, parent permission slips (see below) must be signed and returned to the Main Office. Any student who attends the tutorial sessions must remain in the tutoring location from 3:45 p.m. – 4:45 p.m. or until the tutoring sessions ends. Students are required to be on time for all tutoring sessions and behave appropriately. All students are responsible for their own transportation and must be off campus by 5:00 p.m. Failure to comply with any of the above stipulations may result in a student’s dismissal from the afterschool tutorial program.
