

Final Exam Exemption Policy (formerly Attendance Incentive Policy)

A student may exempt one non-AP course final exam per semester and all AP class final exams if ALL of the following criteria are met.

Students may not exempt the final exam in a Post AP course.

- a. Students must be enrolled within the first 3 days of the semester to qualify.
- b. Students may exempt ONE final exam if they have at least a 70% in the class.
- c. Students may also exempt any AP class final if they register for the AP Exam AND meet the grade requirement. If student exempts in the fall and fails to take the AP Exam they may not qualify for exemption in the future.
- d. Student may NOT exempt End of Course Tests even if they meet the AIP criteria.
- e. An assignment to ISS, OSS or Admin Detention voids the exemption for the semester of the incident.
- f. Any cheating incident voids the exemption for the semester of the incident.
