Wheeler High School provides Learning Links to help students succeed in their academic coursework. In addition, Learning Links tutoring sessions will also prepare students to do their best on the Georgia High School Graduation Tests in English language arts, math, science, and social studies in the spring.

We encourage your child to participate in Learning Links. Tutoring will be offered on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3:30 until 5:00 by certified teachers here at Wheeler High School. Students meet in the library by 3:30 and then go to a designated classroom for a particular content area. Subjects offered are English, math, research, science and social studies. Free bus transportation is available to all in-district students who attend an entire Learning Links session from 3:30 until 5:00.
