Dear Parents/Guardians:

In compliance with the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) and Georgia HB244, students in grades six through eight will be assessed with End of Grade (EOG) assessments in English Language Arts and Mathematics, and students in grade eight will also be assessed in Science and Social Studies. These End of Grade assessments are part of the **Georgia Milestones Assessment System**.

The purpose of these assessments is to measure how well students have mastered the state-adopted content standards. The majority of each assessment will still include selected response items (multiple choice); however, constructed response and extended response questions will be included in the English Language Arts and Mathematics sections. Individual student reports for all students and content areas are expected to arrive during the summer. Cobb County teachers and students have been working all year to ensure that students are prepared to take these grade level assessments.

Students will take these assessments following the schedule below. Please ensure that your student arrives on time to school during the administration window.
