Work/Study Habits

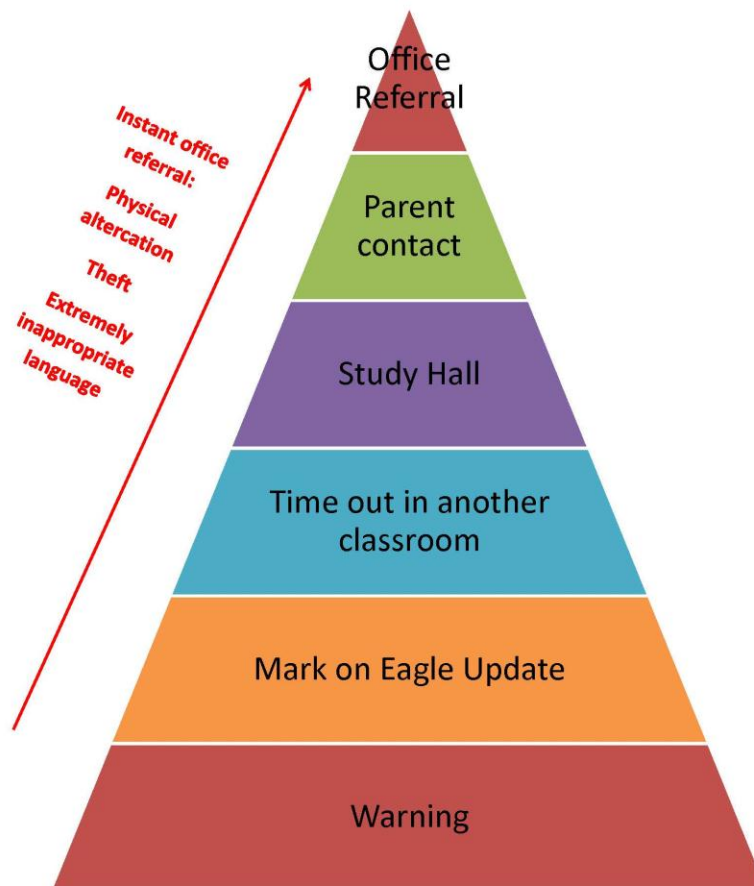
- *Raise your hand to ask a question or speak

Big Shanty Behavior Pyramid

If a child should make the decision not to demonstrate his/her "Big Shanty Excellent Eagles" and his/her behavior interferes with the maintenance of good order and discipline at school and school-sponsored activities, it is considered **MISCONDUCT**. Because this conduct would negatively affect morale, learning, and good conduct of other students, consequences are designed to correct that misconduct and to encourage all students to adhere to their responsibilities as citizens of the Big Shanty Community.

The **Big Shanty Excellent Eagles Project** is a progressive discipline plan. These levels of discipline are aligned with the Cobb County School District's Code of Student Behavior.



Excellent Eagles Instructions

Daily Eagle Report

- Each child at Big Shanty will be receiving an Excellent Eagles Student Agenda
- This agenda will travel with your student everywhere he/she goes in the building
- When a child does not follow classroom and school procedures, their agenda will be initialed by any member on our staff. A comment will be included if necessary.
- Please review your child's agenda daily. **Parents must sign in appropriate space.**
- **Students must bring their agenda every day.**
- Classroom teachers will hold weekly meetings in order to maintain focus on our school-wide goals of respect, self-control, and living the golden rule.
- During the meeting, teachers may wish to discuss with his or her class topics such as: what went well in the past week, what did not go well in the past week, lessons on taking responsibility for your actions, how to apologize, etc.

REWARDS!

We would like to recognize students with outstanding Eagle behavior with an Excellent Eagle Awards Ceremony every nine weeks. Parents will be invited to attend the recognition - look for your invitation!

- Eagle Award Ceremony: awards are based on performance that has been documented on the Eagle Update.
- Dress for Success: On the day of the Eagle Award Ceremony, students will be encouraged to "dress for success" in order to show pride in themselves and their school.
- Golden Eagle: 0 marks on update (per 9 weeks).
- Blue Eagle: 3 or less marks on update (per 9 weeks).
- Parents and all students will attend the ceremony, where students will receive a certificate and a blue or gold dog tag for his/her backpacks.
- Excellent Eagles: Any teacher or staff member may write a child's name on an eagle die-cut who has exhibited "Eagle Pride"; above and beyond behavior.
- The eagle will be placed in a "nest" in the front office. Two will be drawn each Friday. These students will receive a golden eagle pencil. All students' names from the fishbowl will be placed on the bulletin board outside the cafeteria.
- Eagle Club Café: A cafeteria monitor will select 2 students per class, per week, who have shown exceptional lunchroom behavior. These students will be able to eat lunch on the stage on Friday at a special table with a table cloth.
