**2018-2019 DRESS CODE**

The purpose of dress code is to promote a safe, academically focused environment. **All dress code expectations apply to all students.**

- Pants should be worn at the hips or waist. No undershorts or under garments should be exposed. No sagging.
- Pants/shorts with modest holes are acceptable. Skin should not be visible through the holes above the knees. The length of any pants, skirts, dresses, or shorts should not be shorter than fingertip length.
- Slits in skirts must not extend higher than fingertip length.
- Shirts or blouses must be long enough to cover the waistline even when the arms are extended above the head. The skin on the torso should never be visible.
- Spaghetti strap tops, halter tops, strapless tops, crop tops and see through garments are not permitted. Complete shoulders should never be exposed.
- Sleepwear, pajamas and pajama pants and slippers are prohibited.
- No headgear of any kind (including hats, stocking caps, do-rags, bandanas, and sunglasses) is to be worn. Medical and/or religious exceptions must be approved by administration.
- The hoods of hooded sweatshirts are not allowed on your head while in the building.
- Clothing items that reference illegal substances, alcohol, tobacco products, violence, obscene pictures or words, and/or nudity are not permitted.
- Earplugs for phones or any other electronics should be worn leaving one side out during class change.

*The school reserves the right to revise the above list at any time and to make judgments in individual cases.*

**Students who wear inappropriate clothing to school will be sent to ISS for a warning and given the opportunity to call home for a change of clothing or be placed in ISS for the remainder of the day. Additional dress code violations will result in disciplinary action to include but not limited to ISS or OSS.**
