Financial Division Management Practices

- Organizational Depth - The division strives for organizational depth where departments are “two-deep” in critical processes.
- Internal Control Environment (Financial Procedures) – **The division has developed an award winning tool entitled *Financial Services University* where all district administrative and school staff have online access to financial procedures 24/7. The tool is evolving as online testing will soon be implemented to ensure content mastery of training modules.**

Financial Services Staff Training

- Professional Development - All Financial Services Division staff are encouraged to take financial courses and attend financial seminars related to their position. Additionally, the district funds continuing education requirements for certified financial staff positions. Leadership and teambuilding skills are emphasized in multi-level division and department staff meetings.
