## Payment Information

**Paying for Meals**—Register online with [www.mypaymentsplus.com](http://www.mypaymentsplus.com) where you can make payments to meal accounts, get low balance alerts, and see detailed purchase history online. You can also make payments by sending cash or check to school with your child. Talk to your school's Cafeteria Manager if you would like more information regarding monitoring your child's account.

**Charges**—Cobb has a LIMITED charge policy. If a student arrives at school without money, they are allowed up to \$6.75 in charges at elementary school and \$5.00 at middle school. Charges are not allowed for a la carte, adults, or at high school.
