

The **Georgia Ethics for Educational Leadership – Program Entry (370) Assessment** can be taken online from home via the GACE website at <http://gace.ets.org/>. The current cost is \$40.

First, you will need to obtain approval from the Georgia Professional Standards Commission (GAPSC) to take the assessment. Go to the GAPSC website at <http://www.gapsc.com/>. Login to your MyPSC account and click on “Assessments” at the top of the page.

Slide down and choose reason number 7 then “Educator Ethics – Leader Entry” in the dropdown box.

You will receive an approval email from the GAPSC with payment and registration instructions. Again, you will complete the **Georgia Ethics for Educational Leadership – Program Entry (370) Assessment**.

Below are a few tips from one of our employees who recently completed the assessment.

“It’s a series of 7 modules. In those modules there are several videos that you watch, with scenarios that follow. The various videos and scenarios walk you through each of the different sections of the Code of Ethics. At the end of 5 of the modules (3-7) you take a final assessment. This is what indicates your score and completion. It will not let you skip modules and you must go in order. I think that it took me a total of 4 uninterrupted hours to complete the assessment start to finish. Please let folks know that the beauty of this set up is you can stop and start the assessment and modules as needed. I did mine in a total of three sessions based on my available time to work on them. I definitely recommend that folks work on this when they have no distractions as some of the questions are very detail oriented and you need to be able to really pay attention to the scenarios.”
