Why do we have a school council?

The A+ Education Reform Act (HB1187) established school councils in Georgia to "bring communities and schools closer together in a spirit of cooperation to solve difficult educational problems, improve academic achievement, provide support for teachers and administrators, and bring parents into the school-based decision-making process."

What does the school council do?

The Council functions as an advisory body, offering recommendations and assistance on matters relating to student achievement and school improvement.

Who serves on the school council?

The Principal

Two certified teachers are elected by the teachers.

Two parents/guardians are elected by the parents.

Two businessperson parent/guardians are elected by the parents.
