

EASTVALLEY READING CLUB (EVRC) 2018-2019

Books for Breakfast is a celebration for students who have excelled at reading throughout the school year. The Eastvalley PTA hosts the event at the end of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd periods. Our school wide point's goal for this year is 32,500. *Please note that again this year we will have THREE breakfasts instead of four.

HOW BOOKS FOR BREAKFAST POINTS ARE EARNED:

- Student reads an Accelerated Reader (AR) book on their reading level (you can check if book is testable at www.arbookfind.com)
- Student takes the AR test independently in the classroom or the media center. **Tests cannot be taken at home.**
- Tests are scored based on the number of correct answers. Passing is 80% or more correct answers.
- At the beginning of each nine weeks, student's scores reset to 0.
- Point goals must be met by the cutoff date for each nine-week period.

Accelerated Reader (AR) has been rated the nation's best selling reading motivation program. The program is used in many of the Cobb County Elementary schools. The program provides valuable information on the student's reading comprehension and reading level.
