Scholarships

Gates Millennium Scholars Program

Hispanic, African-American, American Indian, or Asian Pacific Islander seniors who have an outstanding academic record, significant financial need, and demonstrated leadership skills are eligible for the Gates Millennium Scholars Program. University of Miami – George Jenkins Scholarship Program
