ACCEPTABLE SCHOOL ATTIRE**

PROHIBITED GARMENTS ON DRESS DOWN DAYS *(Inclusive, but not limited to the following):*

- Garments that portray/advocate profanity, physical aggression, violence, or any illegal/immoral activities
- No holes in jeans
- Hats, caps, bandannas, headbands, head coverings of any kind not pertaining to religious affiliations
- Sunglasses inside the building
- Pajamas
- No bed sandals/slippers/open-toe shoes/flip flops
- No leggings, Spandex pants, no shorts shorter than 3 inches above the knee
- Open weave mesh clothing – no holes in tops and/or pants
- Tank tops
- Hair ornaments—combs, chopsticks, hair picks
- No clothing with offensive or inappropriate writing across the chest area or rear pelvic area
- Any other item, which is distracting and interferes with the normal operations of the school day

Appropriate Dress Attire will be enforced by school administrators and teachers. The principal or his/her designee is the final judge as to the appropriateness, neatness and cleanliness of the wearing apparel, or whether or not apparel is disruptive, distracting, or in violation of the acceptable school attire.
