What’s Happening?

MATH: Students are partitioning a rectangle into rows and columns of the same size squares. **You can help your child at home by drawing a rectangle and have your child make rows and columns, write the amount of each, and also count the total squares made.**

READING: This week in Reading, students will identify the main idea of a nonfiction multi-paragraph text. **At home, have your child use the title and details to figure out the main idea of a paragraph.**
