What's Happening?

MATH: Students will review adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers within 1000. **At home, have your child use a strategy to complete an addition or subtraction equation and explain the strategy used.**

We are also reviewing fact fluency. **Students are to add and subtract within 20 by memory. At home, have your child make flash cards.**

READING: This week in Reading, students will identify the main idea of a nonfiction multi-paragraph text. **At home, have your child use the title and details to figure out the main idea of a paragraph.**

WRITING: In writing this week, students are reviewing narrative writing. **At home, have your child write a personal narrative about a small moment in their life. The story should include a beginning, details, transition words, and a closing statement.**

SCIENCE: Students are continuing the study of life cycles of different animals and plants. **At home, have your child discuss, write about or draw the life cycle of the animal or plant that they learned about this week.**
