What's Happening?

MATH: As we work on two- and three-digit numbers, make up simple word problems with your child. For example, ask "If we buy 25 apples and Grandma buys 10 more, how many will we have to bake pies tonight?"

READING: We will continue focusing on comprehension with WHO, WHAT, WHERE, WHEN and WHY questions. **Fold a piece of paper into 5 sections and have your child illustrate/write about each part of a story you read together.**

WRITING: As we write about small moments, we encourage use of temporal words to show the order of events. **Talk with your child about life events and remind him/her to include these words in writing (then, next, finally, etc.).**

SCIENCE: While our focus is on social studies this week, it's a great time to observe the outdoors and changes in nature. **Talk about this with your child: trees, temperature, the length of day light, etc.**

SOCIAL STUDIES: We are studying the regions in Georgia. Do you know the major regions in our state? **Google "regions of GA" together to study the map.**
