What are we studying?


Reading – Next week, we will be reviewing a previously taught standard. We will be determining our own point of view from that of an author. We will continue discussing and practicing the four basic strokes of cursive: downcurve, overcurve, undercurve, and slant.

Math – Next week, we will be reviewing previously learned skills on how to recognize fractions, fractions on a number line, comparing fractions, and equivalent fractions. Please encourage your child to practice all strategies.

Science – Next week, we will continue on our final unit of study, heat. Students will be obtaining information about the ways heat energy is transferred and measured (examples could include sunlight, friction, and burning). Ask your student to talk about the lesson Ms. Davis taught to our class.

Social Studies – Next week, we will continue learning about the three branches of national and state government: executive, legislative, and judicial. We will be describing and stating the main responsibility of each branch (national and state).
