## Reading/Literacy

This week in reading, students will continue with comparing and contrasting the adventures and experiences of characters in familiar stories such as: *Good Night Moon* and *Good Night Ipad*.

Students will learn about American Symbols such as the Star Spangled Banner, Independence Day and the Statue of Liberty.

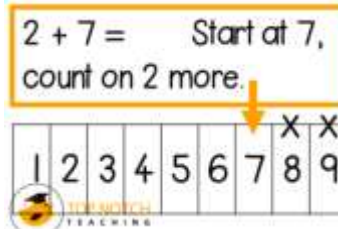


Students will also learn what it means to be a good citizen.

## Phonics/Literacy

Our focus letters this week are **Xx** and **Zz**. Students will continue blending these and previously taught letters to create words.

We will continue working on rhyming words, counting the syllables, focusing on the initial, medial and ending sounds of a words, and segmenting and blending words.

Give your child a word and have them tell you the beginning, middle, and ending sound.

**To help your child at home, go on letter hunts. Your child should be able to identify the beginning letter sound for any object in your home. Example: Show your child a pencil. Ask what is the beginning letter sound, and then identify the letter that makes that sound.**

## SCIENCE

Students will continue to learn about living and non-living things. We will also learn about plants.
