Dear Parents:

As we approach the close of the semester, please be aware that all students will be given comprehensive final exams covering the curriculum of each course they are currently taking (unless the course is year-long). These exams will be given according to the following schedule:

- Tuesday, December 19th: 1st and 2nd period exams
- Wednesday, December 20th: 3rd and 4th period exams

STUDENTS WILL BE DISMISSED FROM SCHOOL AT 11:30 A.M. BOTH DAYS

BUS TRANSPORTATION WILL BE PROVIDED AT 11:30 A.M. ONLY ON BOTH DAYS.

Grab and Go Lunches will be available for students to purchase from the main cafeteria at dismissal (students will need to purchase these immediately following the bell in order to make the bus.

Students are not allowed to remain on campus after 11:30 a.m. on Final Exam Days.

All students are required to take final exams at the regularly scheduled time. Students are not authorized to take finals early. Students who are absent during the final exam days must have a documented excuse to make up any exam missed. The excuse must be approved by the Administration prior to taking any exam missed. Students are responsible for scheduling a time convenient to their teacher in which to make up an excused missed exam. This make-up must take place by no later than January 18, 2018.

Students who miss finals or EOC tests for any reason will receive a grade of "zero" for the exam, and the grade will be changed once the exam is made up, assuming the absence is excused.
