

Promotion Criteria

Per Cobb County School District Policy, the following applies:

Students shall be on track to advance with the graduating class they enter as a ninth grader (or under which they are placed upon transfer) with the following indicators:

- a. Maintain the following minimum units of credit required for promotion.
 - 10th grade: 5 units
 - 11th grade: 10 units
 - 12th grade: 16 units
- b. For students enrolling in the ninth grade for the first time in the 2008-2009 school year and for subsequent years, the following requirements must also be met in order to advance with the entering graduating class:
 - 10th grade: 5 units, including one full credit each of required coursework in Mathematics, Science, and English Language Arts.
 - 11th grade: 10 units, including two full units each of required coursework in Mathematics, Science, and English Language Arts.
- c. Students must complete state testing requirements in EOCT courses and must take the Georgia High School Graduation Test before being considered a senior. Students placed in ninth grade who do not meet expectations on the math and/or reading portions of the eighth grade CRCT (state rule 160-4-2.11) shall be placed in skills-building math and/or reading classes in the ninth grade.
