We need your help! Each year the Georgia Department of Education sends out a survey to the parents of the schools in Georgia to get feedback. A lot of people don't know that the results of the survey are actually used to help determine part of our school's CCRPI score. Last year our score was 69.4. We are working hard this year to try and improve our score from last year, and we need your help by taking the survey for this year. The Georgia Parent Survey contains 24 questions. Parents may complete the survey using their personal computer, smartphone, or tablet. Survey responses are anonymous and will be submitted directly to the Georgia Department of Education for analysis. The Georgia Parent Survey is also available in Spanish.
