Dear Parents/Guardians:

Your child is currently enrolled in a course that requires a state administered End of Course (EOC) assessment. The State Board of Education rule requires that the grade on the EOC assessment be counted as 20% of the final course grade. In late August, the State Board passed a one year waiver of the requirement to include EOC grades in a student's final grade due to an anticipated delay in returning the results back to the local schools. Therefore, teachers in Cobb County will still administer the EOC assessment, along with a locally developed final exam. Accordingly, teachers have adjusted their syllabi to include the final exam rather than the End of Course assessment. Please be aware that the EOC assessment grades will still be reported on transcripts. Teachers will be sending home and posting on their blogs their updated syllabus that reflects these changes.
